




The Forgotten International

THE WORK WE DO

Founded in 2007, The Forgotten International (TFI) is based in San Francisco, CA, operates entirely on donations, and focuses its resources within four main program areas: *Small Grants, Volunteer Service, Donations of Goods and Supplies, and Awareness Building.*

Small Grants

TFI makes targeted grants to trusted community organizations, village schools, charitable medical clinics, and orphanages that make the most of all their resources. Since our inception, we have helped 37 mostly grassroots organizations in Cambodia, India, Kenya, Niger, Peru, Thailand, Uganda, Vietnam, and the United States. We are presently researching new opportunities to help in Nepal and Mexico.

Volunteer Service

Through our **Fellowship Program**, TFI sends skilled volunteers to live and work abroad for a minimum of two months with grassroots organizations we support that directly serve those most in need in the local community. By the end of 2014, we will have sent 21 Fellows to 10 agencies in six countries: Cambodia, India, Kenya, Nepal, Peru, and Uganda.

Goods and Supplies

In collaboration with our Partners, TFI sends needed goods and supplies to communities in need of the bare essentials around the world. TFI has delivered clothing, shoes, educational and medical supplies, as well as toys for children in slum schools, orphanages, and charitable clinics in India and Peru. We will make our next delivery to children and families in Cambodia.

Awareness Building

TFI seeks to raise awareness of the problem of global poverty through presentations at public forums, as well as through our **Compassion Education Project** which uses our curriculum *Doing Good* to introduce high school-aged youth to poverty-related issues and encourages them to think and act in a compassionate way toward others in our global community.

Additionally, our book *Living on a Dollar a Day: The Lives and Faces of the World's Poor* tells the stories, in words and images, of the 1.2 billion people on earth who survive on less than one dollar a day. Personal profiles of more than 40 individuals and families were captured from 10 countries around the world to produce this book. The Foreword was written by His Holiness the 14th Dalai Lama.
