Stipend Arrangement – New as of 2017

TFI will pay 75% of the total budget or up to \$2,500, whichever is less, based on an 8- week stay. These funds are to help off-set the travel-related costs a volunteer would incur when living and working abroad. The stipend is not payment for hours worked on site, and the Fellow will not receive a salary from the host NGO.

TFI Fellows receive 50% of budgeted costs before they leave to go abroad and up to 25% upon completion of their work assignment and submission of a short report and some photos about their work experiences.

For the above Sample Budget, 75% of the total budget would be \$2,587.50. Per our guidelines, that means, TFI will reimburse the Fellow 50% (or \$1,725) of the total (\$3,450) before they travel abroad (half of \$3450 is \$1725). Upon completion of their assignment and submission of a short report and some photos from their work experience, TFI will reimburse the Fellow an additional \$775, which brings the total to our maximum of \$2,500 (\$1,725 plus \$775 = \$2,500). This is slightly less than the remaining 25% because 75% of the total approved budget would be \$2,587.50, and that exceeds our limit of \$2,500. In short, the Fellow receives either 75% of his/her approved budget or \$2,500, whichever is less.
