

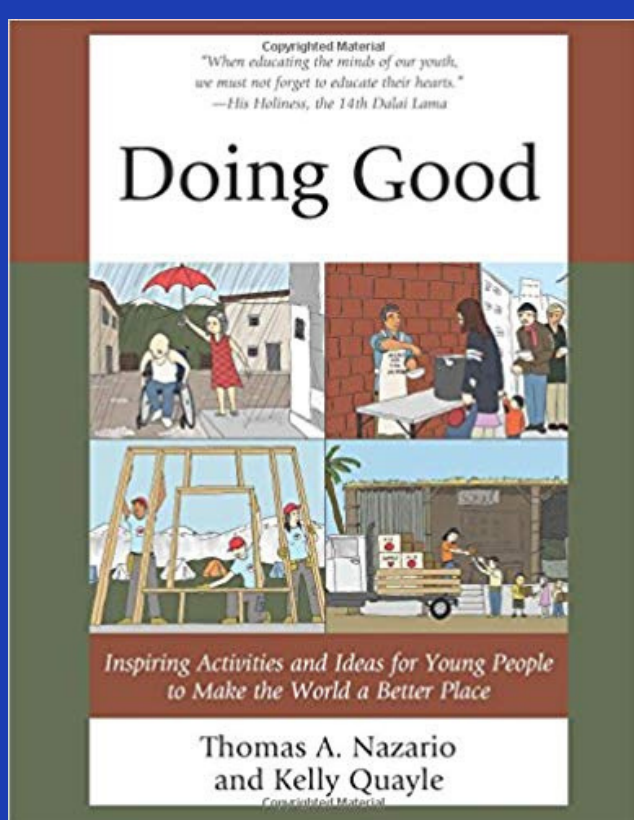
THE ANNUAL "DOING GOOD" AWARDS CONTEST

Every spring, The Forgotten International foundation holds a contest in California to encourage students throughout the state to get involved with their classmates and create a project that works to help others in need, either in their own communities or somewhere around the world.

RULES

THE PROJECT MUST...



- Be completed by July 31 of any given year.
- Be completed by students as part of a class or after-school club program or exercise.
- Be supervised by a teacher, coach, or school volunteer who has been approved to work with students at the school.
- Be done in conjunction with the teaching of the *Doing Good* curriculum materials, and those who plan on participating in this year's contest must notify us by email at info@theforgottenintl.org by **March 1st** of that year so that we can send you information about criteria that we will be using to judge the contest. In your notification to us, please put "Doing Good Contest" in the subject line.

Students who are judged to have created the best and most beneficial project over the course of this spring will receive a check for **\$5,000** to be used to benefit the non-profit of their choice.

The teacher, coach, or school volunteer who works with the award-winning students over the course of the year will receive an additional **\$2,500** to give to his or her school or to a nonprofit of their choice.
